The Representative DeMolay Award is given for completing a self evaluation application. In the application, the DeMolay is asked to reflect on his life in school, athletics, and DeMolay. In addition, the application asks him to comment on his activities in the community and his church.

The Representative DeMolay award is a revealing study of the type of person he is. He rates his progress in the fields of mental, physical, social, economic and spiritual development. He evaluates his own status, and analyzes his own strengths and weaknesses. The Representative DeMolay Award tells the world that he has

already established a list of definite accomplishments.

The Representative DeMolay Award is the highest self-achievement award an Active DeMolay can receive. Every DeMolay should complete his own Representative DeMolay application. Senior DeMolays may also apply for the Representative DeMolay.

A DeMolay must be a member for at least six months before applying for the Representative DeMolay Award. The application is submitted to the Chapter Dad for his approval, and then on to the Executive Officer for his approval and finally the award is presented.

The ceremony for presenting the Representative DeMolay Award is found in the Monitor of Ceremonies, and the DeMolay is asked to bring his parents if possible. The jewel, riband, lapel pin, and certificate are presented after taking the oath of Representative DeMolay.
