### **Successes of the Past**


As we roll out the new DeMolay programs, we took a look back to what it was several years ago. One thing we found was that Parents Clubs were a big help to our Chapters.

There are many parents who want to be part of their sons' activities, but not want to be on your council. They can provide transportation, refreshments after meetings, help with fundraising events and many other activities.


